Body, Soul*)


We assess each child to understand their thoughts and feelings and what motivates their behaviors to help them respond to disappointments with integrity and maturity.



Holy, Love, Truth

HOLY: For I am the LORD your God. Consecrate yourselves therefore, and be holy, for I am holy. (Leviticus 11:44)

LOVE: So we have come to know and to believe the love that God has for us. God is love, and whoever abides in love abides in God, and God abides in him. (1 John 4:16)

Who AM I?

*Image Bearer, Son/Daughter/
Heir, God's Workmanship*

IMAGE BEARER: So God created man in his own image, in the image of God he created him; male and female he created them. (Genesis 1:27)

SON/DAUGHTER/HEIR: So you are no longer a slave, but a son, and if a son, then an heir through God.

(Galatians 4:7)

GOD'S WORKMANSHIP: For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand, that we should walk in them. (Ephesians 2:10)

UNITE WITH GOD'S PEOPLE: for it is God who works in you, both to will and to work for his good pleasure. (Philippians 2:13)


BE HOLY AS GOD IS HOLY: but as he who called you is holy, you also be holy in all your conduct, since it is written, "You shall be holy, for I am holy."

FRUIT OF THE SPIRIT

Adult Spiritual Growth Series

The Fruit of the Spirit (Galatians 5:22-23) are qualities or characteristics that should naturally grow in us as the Holy Spirit guides us to follow Jesus. These are essential characteristics of a Christian and are central to planting seeds in a child's formative years to teach character development. These qualities are like the "fruits" that grow from a good tree rooted in a relationship with God. They show that a person lives a life influenced by the Holy Spirit. These qualities are:

1. **LOVE:** Wanting what is best for others by putting their needs above yours, speaking the truth to others, (even when the truth is not easy), and helping them avoid wrongdoing.
2. **JOY:** A condition (not a feeling) that comes from knowing your heart, soul, mind, and body are well, even if your circumstances are not.
3. **PEACE:** A confidence and trust in God's control of your life and a calm heart, free of trouble and fear.
4. **PATIENCE:** Continuing to love while not being selfish, jealous, or angry, and not complaining or giving up when we don't get our way.
5. **KINDNESS:** Extending compassion, empathy, and goodwill toward others with gracious words and actions.
6. **GOODNESS:** Being kind, gracious, generous, and loving toward others while respecting them.
7. **FAITHFULNESS:** Being steadfast, loyal, trustworthy, reliable, and true to your word.
8. **GENTLENESS:** Being kind and respectful toward others using a mild tone and attitude in your speech and actions.
9. **SELF-CONTROL:** The ability to control your emotions, desires, and actions in a way that honors God and benefits others over yourself.



I AM THE VINE

You are the branches.

Whoever abides in me bears much fruit.

Apart from me you can do nothing. (John 15:5)

The Fruit of the Spirit has three parts that are interdependent and will be present in different measures in every Christian life:

1. Our essential nature (love, joy, peace)
2. Our relationships with others (patience, kindness, goodness)
3. Our character before God (faithfulness, gentleness, self-control)

God promises that His followers will bear fruit. Fruit in the life of a Christian comes from abiding in Jesus.
